

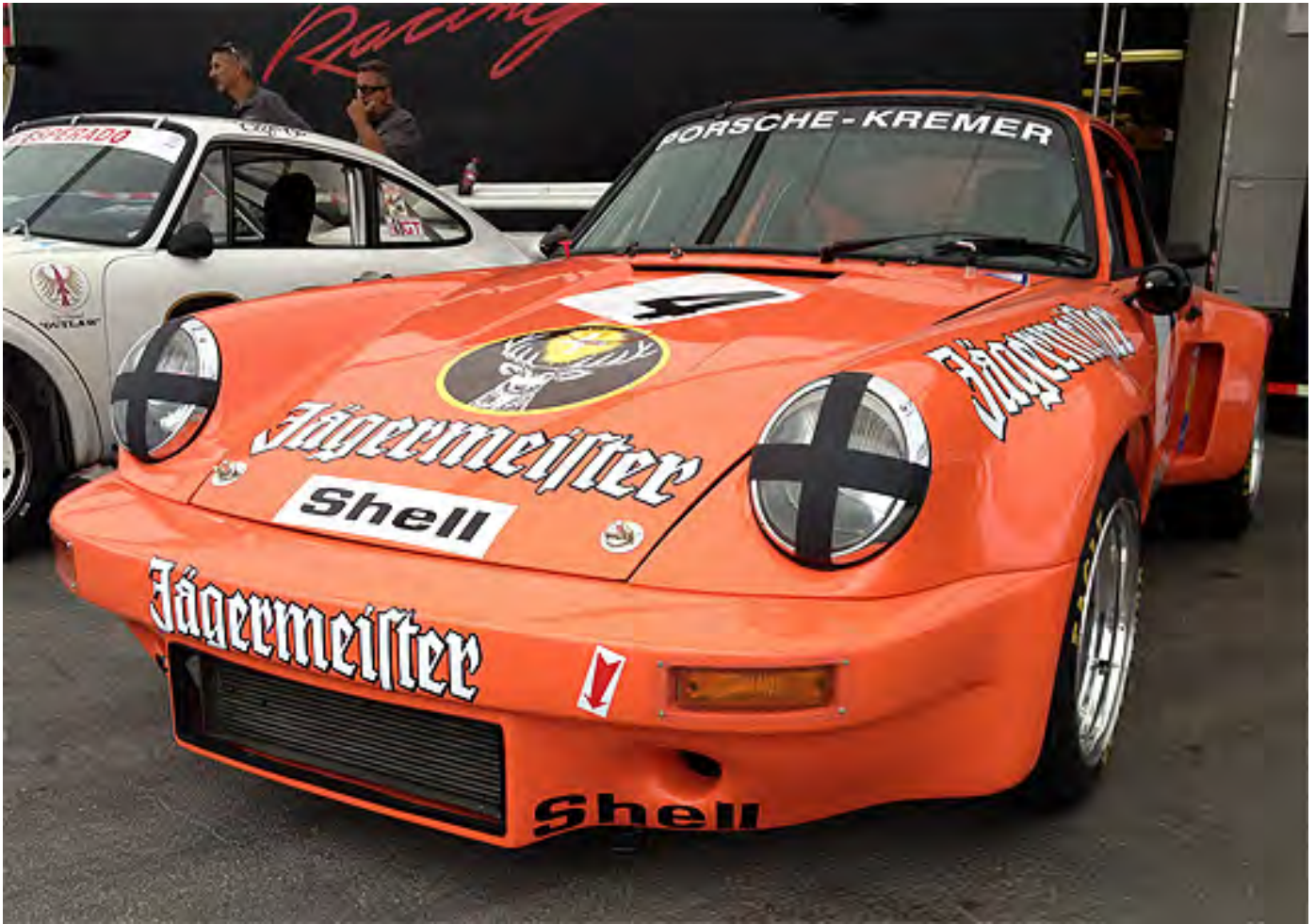
LAGUNA SECA – AUGUST 16TH TO 18TH, 2013
